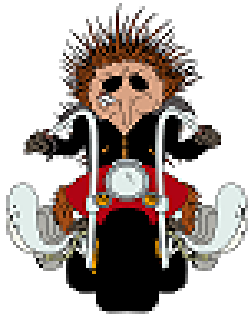

Welcome to the My Puppy application!

The My Puppy applications is a Microsoft Windows desktop application create by [MORC Creations](#) software and runs on Microsoft Windows XP, 8, 10 and above.

The My Puppy application provides the following functionality:

- Store and manage puppy details, including, Name, DOB, Owners, Breed and photos
- Store and manage Weight & Size, Eating Habits, Exercise and Sleeping Habits
- Maintain Vaccination and Medical record information.
- Create multiple photo galleries.
- Store and track Puppy Training and Trick information
- Create multiple graphs and pie chart using assorted information sets.

- Store Financial information and costs
- Keep track puppy's Family and Friends.

1.1. LOGIN SCREEN

Use the **My Puppy Login** screen to access the My Puppy application.

Enter your Username and Password into the associated User Login fields.

You can use the "**Show Password**" button to toggle between seeing the password you enter either masked by asterisks or as plain text, making it easier to ensure you enter the correct password.

The "**My Puppy**" drop down list allows you to optionally select an existing Puppy to open when the application starts.

Alternatively, if you leave the "**My Puppy**" drop down list option set to "<None>", which is the default value, then no Puppy will be opened when the application starts.

If this is the first time you are logging into the My Puppy application, then use the following default administrative credentials:

- **User Name: Admin**
- **Password: Admin**

You can change the administrative password and add additional users using the [User Management](#) option on the [Configuration tab](#) once you have logged in.

1.2. GET LICENSE SCREEN

The first time you open the **My Puppy** application the **Get License Key** screen will be displayed.

Use this screen to enter your license key and unlock the full application functionality.




If you do not already have a license key then press the "**Request License Key**" button and the **Request License Key** screen will be displayed, as shown below.

Enter your Full Name, Address and Email Address into this screen.

Press the "**Request License**" button and this information will be placed into your default email application with the email address line set to morccreations@gmail.com.

Press the Send button to send this email and information to MORC Creations Software. Within 24 hours you will receive you license key.

Reopen the My Puppy application and come back to this screen. Copy and paste your new license key into the License Key field and press the "**Save**" button to gain full access to the My Puppy application.

On receipt of your License Key reopen the My Puppy application and copy and paste the License Key from the MORC Creations email into the License Key field on the Get License Key screen. When you press the "Save" button the license key will be validated and then saved to the application database. You will not need to enter the License Key again in the future and this screen will not be shown again.

If you do not yet have your license key then you can still run the My Puppy application in Trial Mode by pressing the "Use Trial Version" button on the Get License Key screen. In this mode you will be able to see all the screens and functionality within the My Puppy application but will not be able to Save new items to the My Puppy database.

1.3. MY PUPPY MAIN SCREEN

After you have successfully logged into the My Puppy application using a valid User Name and Password combination then the **Main Application** screen will be displayed.

All functionality within the **My Puppy** application may be accessed through the Main Application screen, as shown below.

The My Puppy Main application screen consists of a number of tabs with multiple buttons on each of these tabs.

Each of the edges and the center of the main application screen can act as docking points for various screens within the application.

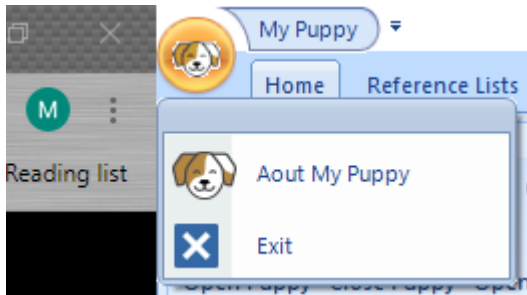

1.3.1. APPLICATION MENU

- [Weight & Size](#): Allows for entry, management and graphing of Puppy Weight & Size.

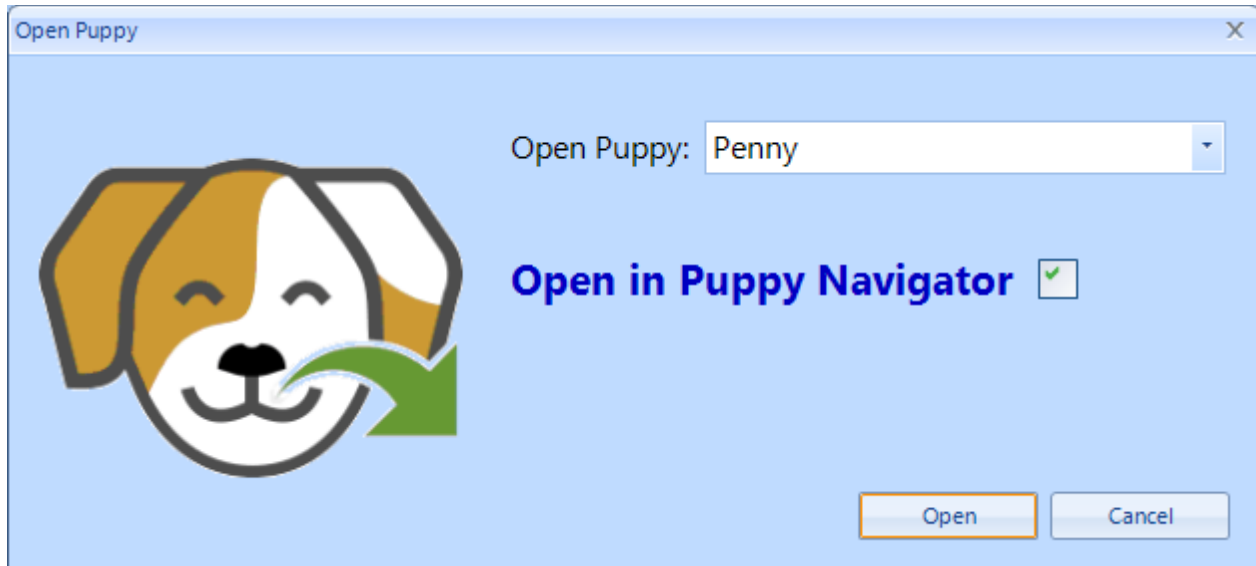

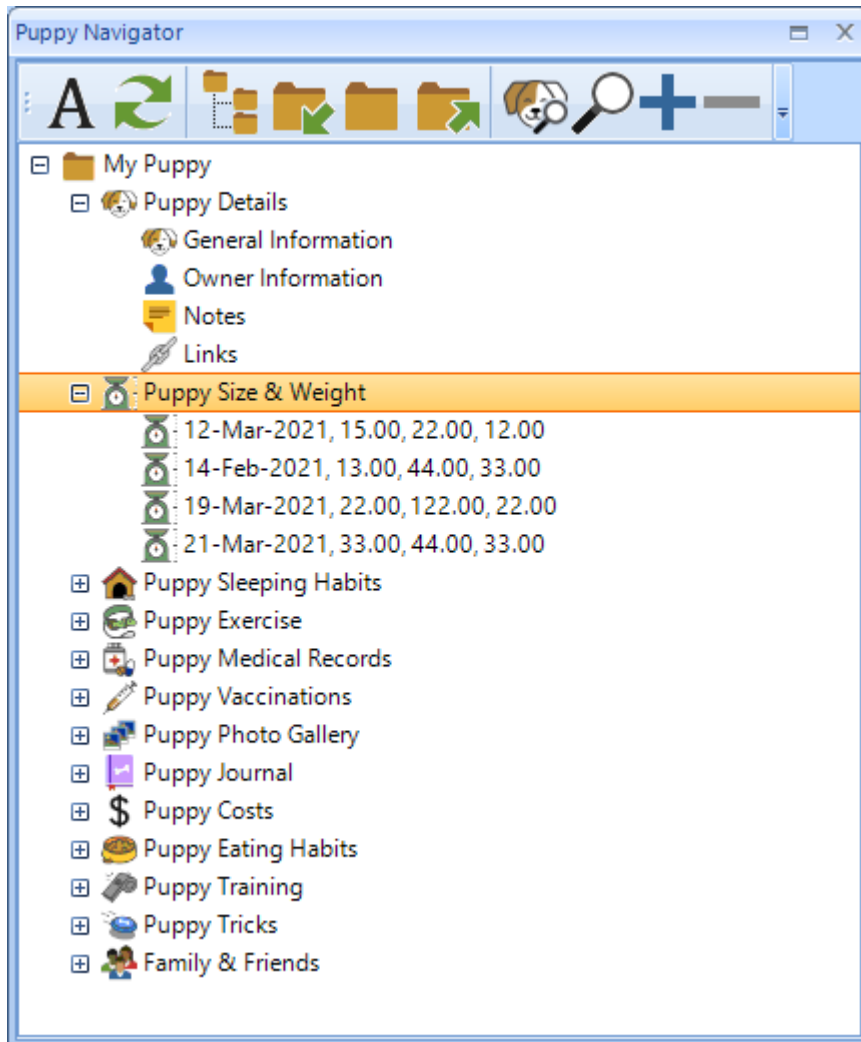

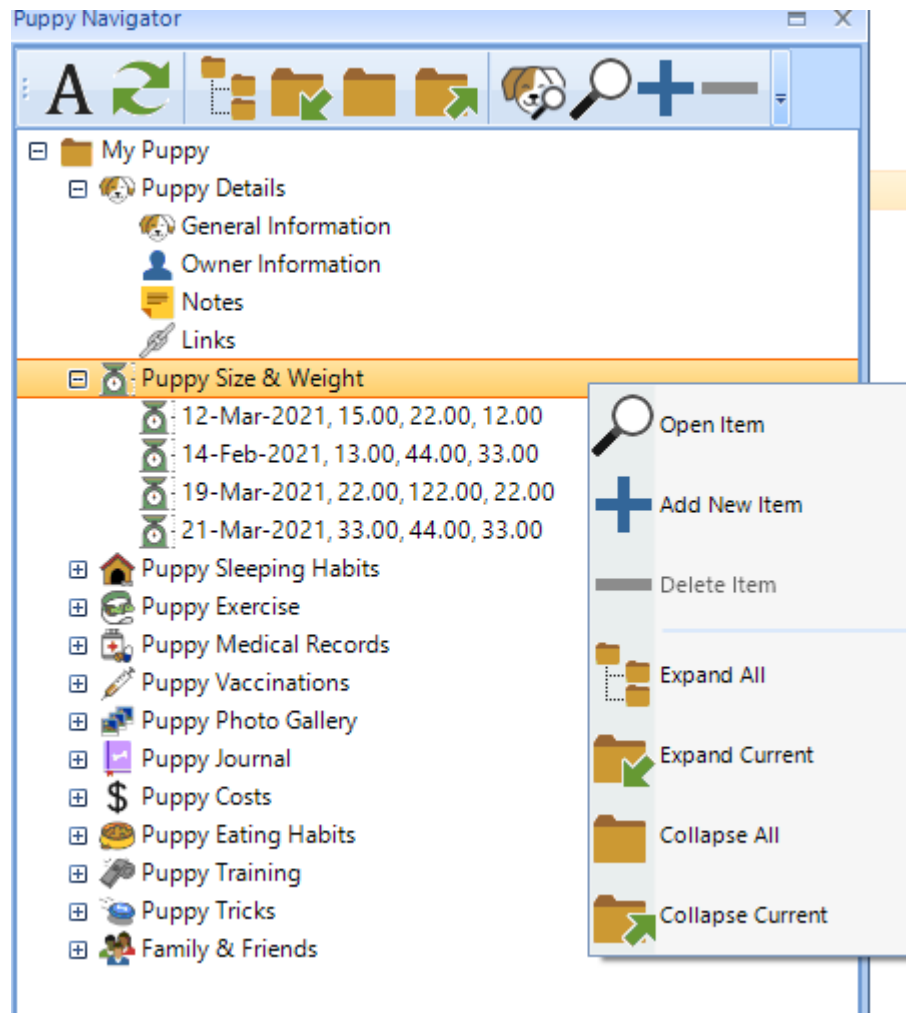


1.3.2.1.2. PUPPY NAVIGATOR

The **Puppy Navigator** provides access to all the puppy data and allows for the addition of new puppy information and access and editing of existing information.




The My Puppy Navigator also has a right mouse click menu which provides access to all the functionality available in the top navigator toolbar.

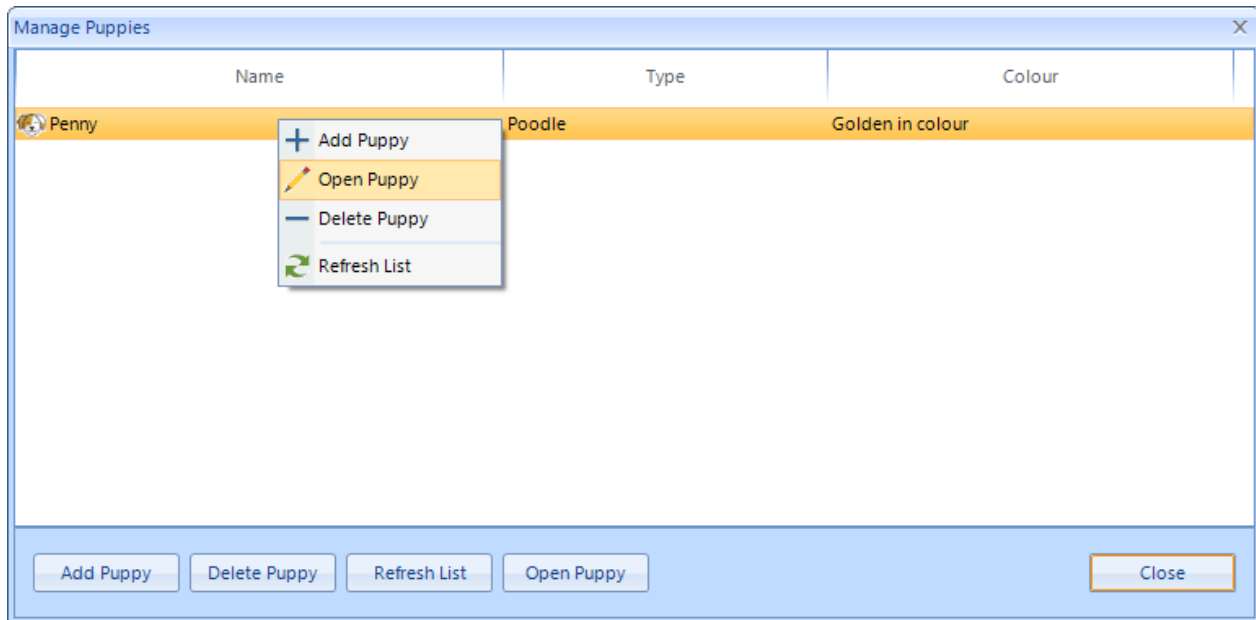

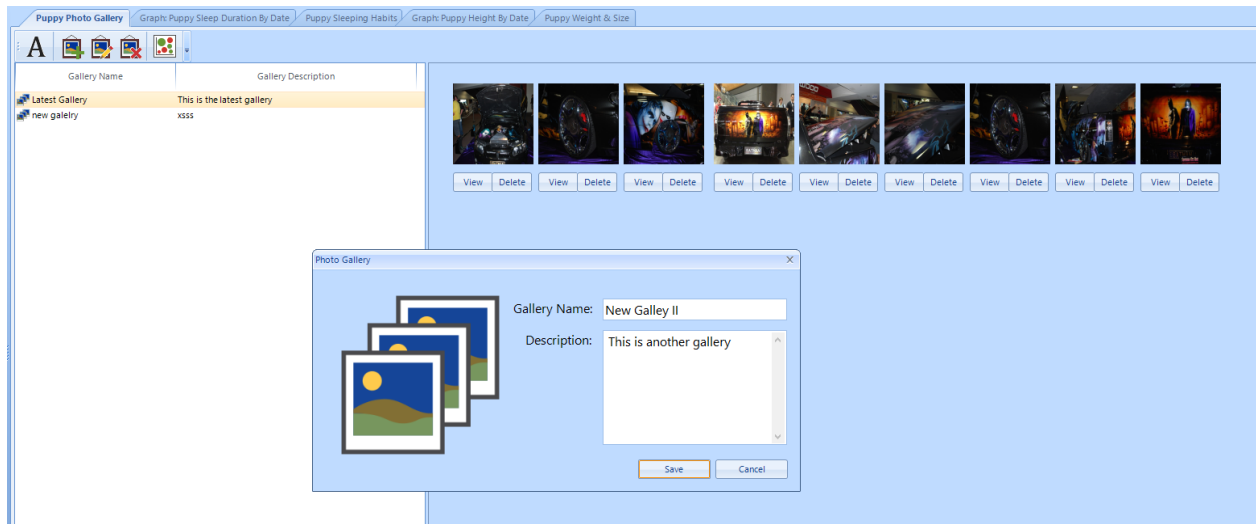

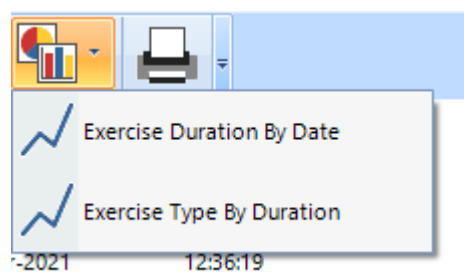

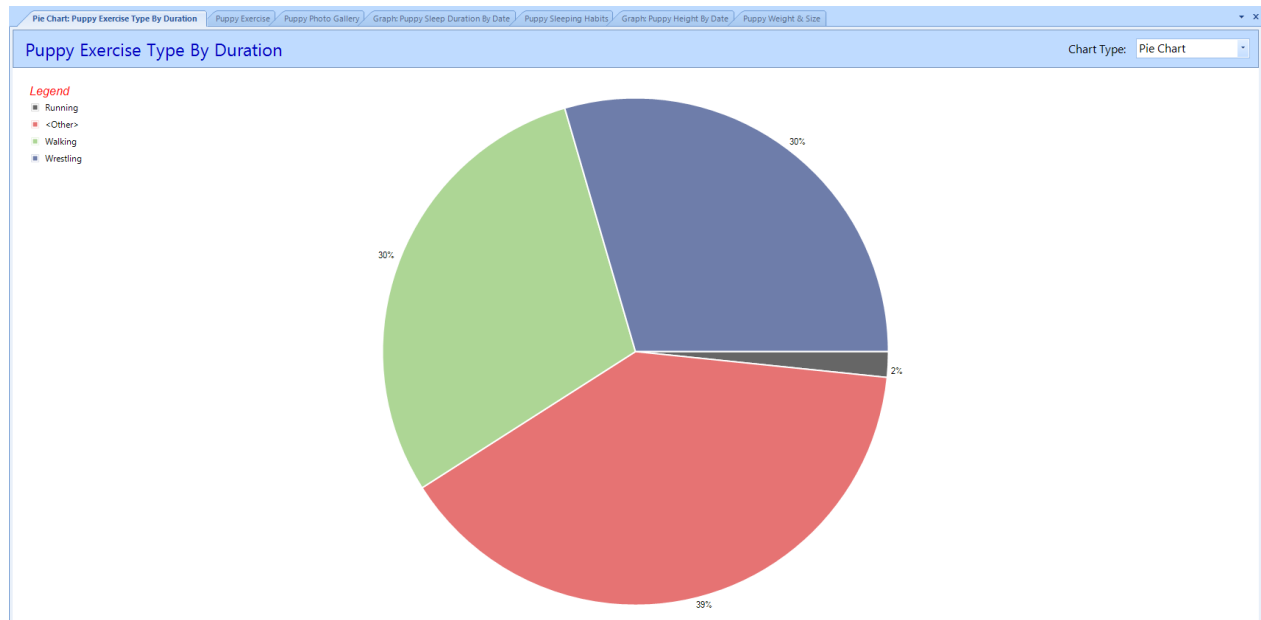



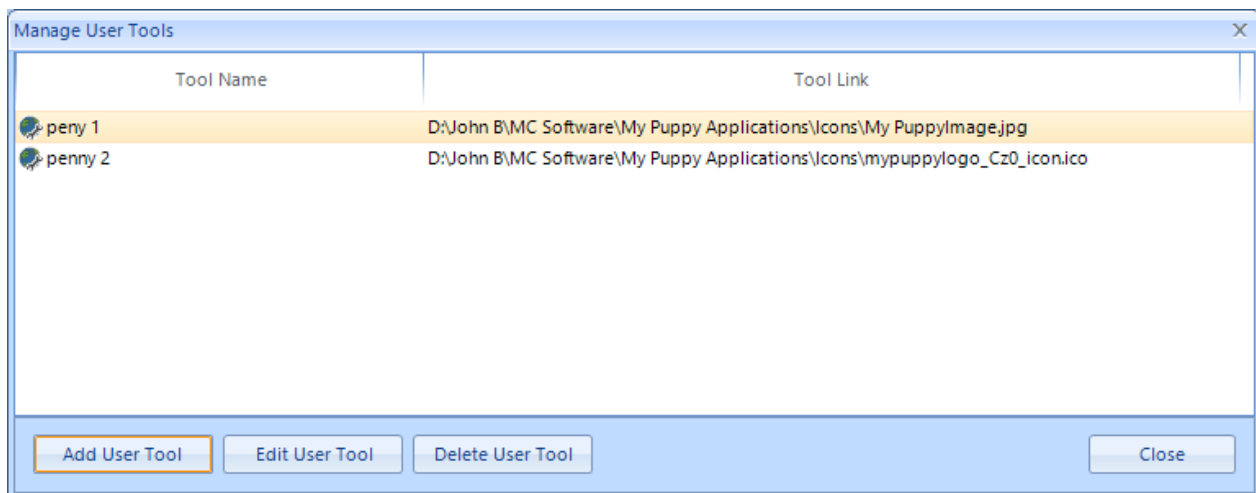


